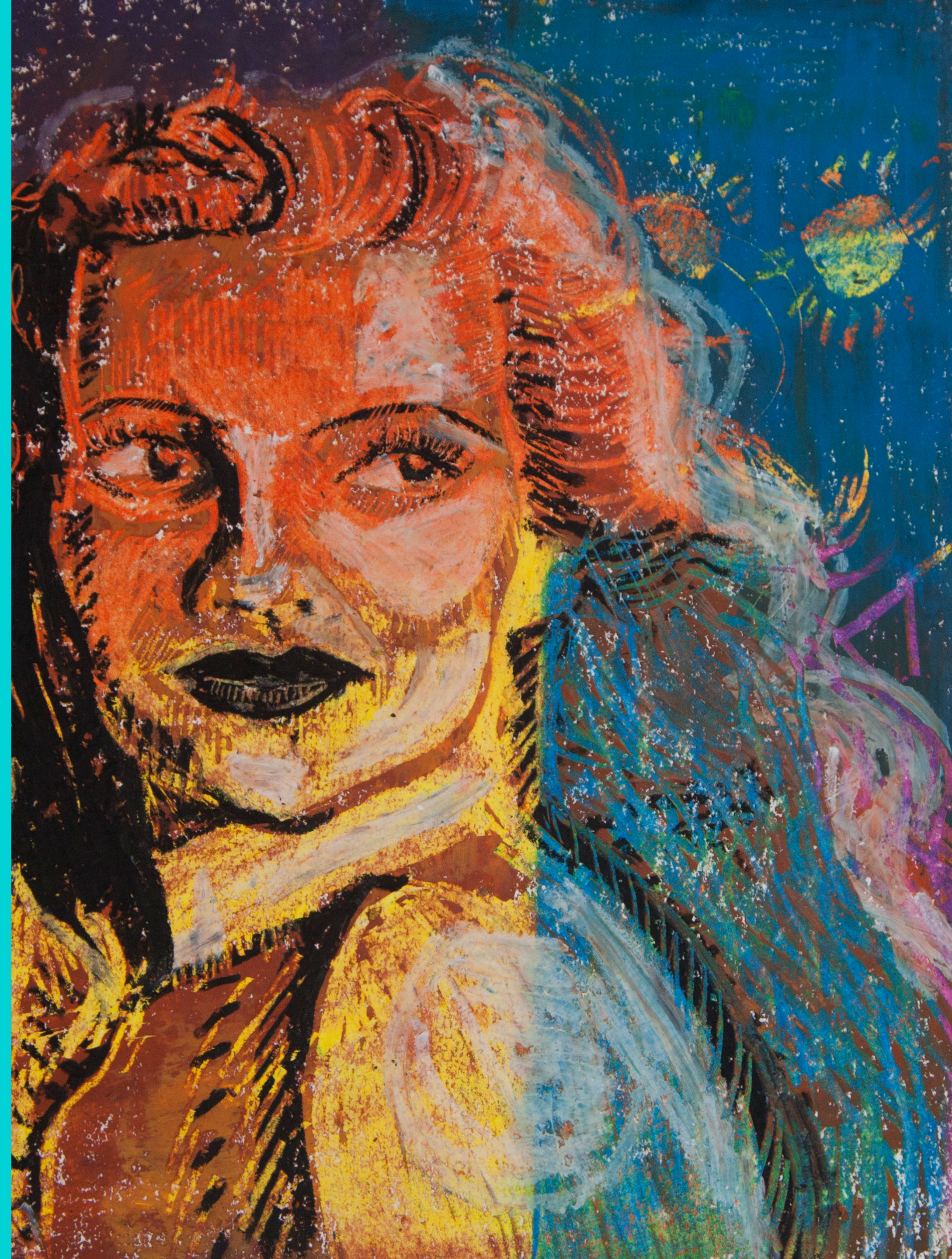
Smart

Over time this bag and its contents will break down into nutrient rich compost that can be used to fertilize and grow your plants and garden.

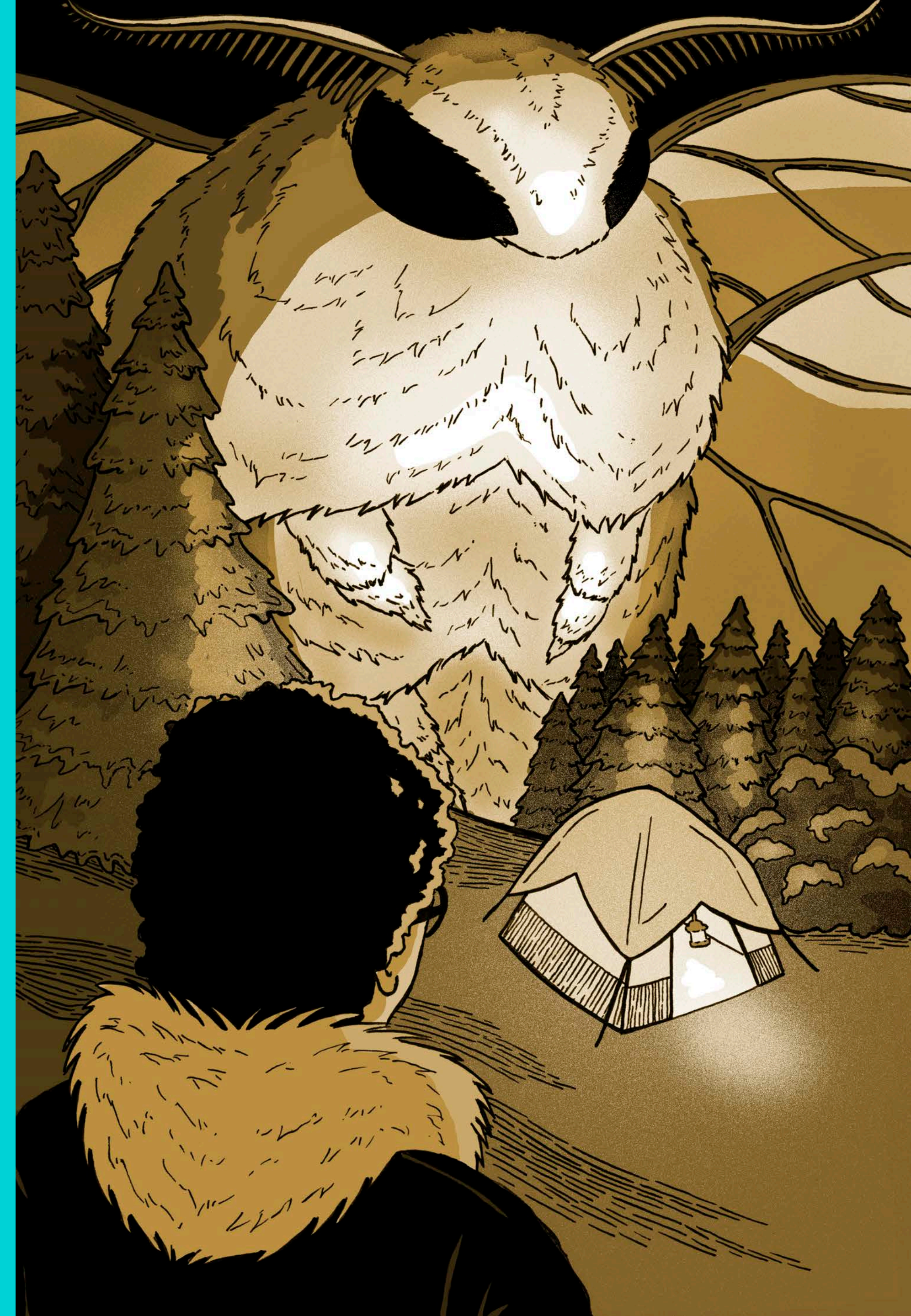
