

Step 1

Create Your Federal Student Aid (FSA) ID

-Visit ***studentaid.gov*** and click on “Create Account”

Students age 23 and younger must report parent data on FAFSA. Therefore, at least one parent reported on the FAFSA must have a FSA ID in addition to the student.

Only first-time FAFSA applicants must create FSA IDs. If you are a renewal applicant, you do not need to create a new FSA ID each year.

Step 2

Apply for Financial Aid

-Complete the 2023–2024 FAFSA at <https://studentaid.gov/h/apply-for-aid/fafsa>

and use the DCAD federal school code 041398

Step 3

Apply for State Financial Aid
